MODEL PREPARATION

If you wish to provide a model for the hands-on session, please be aware of the following:

- . We use NeoStrata Glycolic acid 20% at PH1.6
- . Pre-peel prep with a 10% Glycolic Ultra Smoothing Cream PH3-4 is required for 10-14days before the peel
- . If the patient is not prepared fully, we can do a very superficial Exuviance glycolic peel with a much higher PH that doesn't need prep.
- . We cannot peel skin that is sun burnt but general photodamaged skin is fine.
